Rom München. Hin -und Zurück at halle 50 DomagkAteliers - München

In Munich Marco Angelini exhibits ten artworks featured at the Italian Pavillon of the 54th Venice Biennal of Contemporary Art. The artworks focus on the complex relationship between art and science, and art and medicine.

The artist has the power to make this relationship alive and fruitful through irony and seduction, to establish a sincere dialogue and an unexpected empathy. It should be noted that this is a "carnal" dialogue, full of materials, earth, artifices, energy, chemicals and pigments. However, there is - as always in the art of Marco Angelini - no point of saturation, or severity, indeed, there is a suspended and essential lightweight that dominates.

Marco Angelini will also exhibit an art installation from the Urban Grooves exhibit featured in Warsaw and Bratislava in the month of October 2010.

Serial Hearts: six variations on life at Croissant Gallery - Bruxelles

March 2012 - March 2012 (1 month)

The six pieces of this new exhibition by Marco Angelini are dominated by the image of the heart.

The heart, playing the starring role in each and every painting, stands out from an aseptic background made up of amorphous figures – in a series – that vaguely recall embryos, as if forming a sort of a code, a flow, or rain, of repeated symbols that the heart iterates in itself, for some secret relationship we can only forebode.

Marco Angelini's art project exhibited at Biennale di Venezia 2011 analyzes the relationships between Art and Medicine, and Art and Science.

Angelini finds inspiration in scientific research, in physics, and in the world of medicine.

The artist draws cues for his work from the diffusion of energy and its transformation into light, and the question of the infinite.

Through this new phase of poetics and evolution, Marco Angelini works literally on the "shape of words", used not only as "signifiers" but particularly as visual and sign-like elemental components: graphemes freed from their phonic bond. Translated into shapes and colours, words are elected real contribution/essence to the graphic composition of the piece.

In this exhibition the works are quiet and composed, are in equilibrium.

But the process is not finished: It probably will leads to new forms of creativity, new artwork filtered through a personal and intimate life that makes art.

Restful Turmoil at The Brick Lane Gallery - London

July 2009 - July 2009 (1 month)

The artist returns to canvas after spending some years working on metals and polystyrene, and introduces larger areas of white tones which enhance the inherent and yet unpredictable equilibrium within the work.

These monochromatic backdrops are carefully ruptured by spots of colour, opacity, texture, pigment and finish which subsequently shatter and reinforce this chromatic equilibrium.

Ah - un - tempo at Galleria White Cube 3 - Rome

"Ah" is the first sound you make when you are born, "un" the last sound you make when you die.

"Ah" is the breath inhaled that begins life. Between the two lies all of existence, a universe that turns on a single breath.
