Recently my interests have been zoned in on the ideas of noise and silence, and the relationship between sound and material. I am currently making a new body of work that uses this relationship to explore both the personal and political implications of these ideas. Media include concrete, tactile transducers, bubblewrap, ear plugs, acoustic foam.
