RESEARCH INTERESTS AND STUDIO PRACTICE:

In my academic research, I work to understand how cognitive neuroscience, philosophy, media studies, and fine art work in concert to construct our idea of 'self'. It is through making such analogies that we catch a glimpse of our society as a whole. My studio practice looks at notions of selfhood through the lens of gender, bringing the cultural tropes of woman into focus and into question. Absurd yet insightful performative acts form video installations in which cinematic moments rooted in art historical and mythological bases become entangled in more nuanced and complex narratives. Revealing what lies beneath the surface of femininity, my videos toy with a conclusion that is problematic—gendered, comi-tragic, and most essentially human.
